FACE COVERINGS



- ▶ Customers in Wales are required by law to wear a face covering while in the store, unless they are exempt.
- ▶ You can still ask customers to lower or remove a face covering to ID them for age restricted products like alcohol.
- ▶ Colleagues working in areas accessible to the public (e.g. the shop floor) are required to wear a face covering unless they are exempt

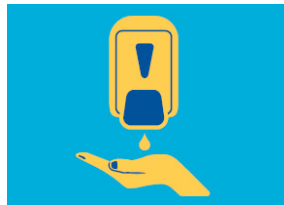
OTHER MEASURES IN STORE

Retailers are legally required to conduct Covid-19 specific risk assessments and have measures in place in store to reduce the risk of spreading Covid-19.

These measures can vary but might include:



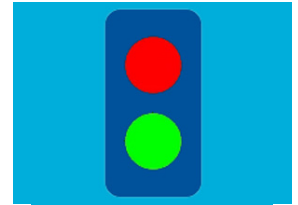
SANITISING BASKETS

SELF ISOLATING



- ▶ If you have any coronavirus symptoms you should self-isolate at home and get a test.
- ▶ If someone in your household has symptoms or has tested positive for coronavirus you should self-isolate and take a PCR test. If your test is negative you can stop isolating.
- ▶ If you have been in close contact with someone who has coronavirus you will not need to self-isolate if you do not have any symptoms. You should get a PCR test on day 2 from your last contact with the positive case (or as soon as possible) and day 8.
